**FOOD VENDOR RULES**

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1. Vendors are responsible for collection and payment of all sales tax. **Every vendor must submit a copy of their Florida Sales Tax Certificate with their application.** (The only exceptions will be vendors who can show a valid "non-profit" status ie: Church groups)
2. No pets are allowed.
3. There are no refunds, unless your application is rejected by the committee as noted above.
4. The festival hours are 10: a.m. to 6 p.m. Set up begins at 7:00 a.m. the day of the festival, at the Bailey F. Ogburn Recreational Facility at 10608 Adams Memorial Drive. There is no security for prior day set-up. Vendors are requested to have booth set-up completed and cars removed by 9:30 a.m.
5. Food vendors will follow the food service guidelines required by the Public Health Department.
6. The White Springs Wild Azalea Festival is not responsible for any lost, stolen or damaged items and reserves the right to refuse space to any exhibitor who does not comply with these rules and food service guidelines.
