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## RESOLUTION 21-01

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF WHITE SPRINGS, HAMILTON COUNTY, FLORIDA; ADOPTING A FINAL MILLAGE RATE FOR THE LEVY OF AD VALOREM TAXES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2021-2022 ON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY LOCATED WITHIN THE TOWN OF WHITE SPRINGS, FLORIDA FOR THE FISCAL COMMENCING OCTOBER 1, 2021 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2022; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Town Council of the Town of White Springs, Florida as follows:

**Section 1.** The Town Council of the Town of White Springs, Florida does hereby adopt its tentative millage rate of 5.5 Mills for ad valorem taxation within the Town of White Springs, Florida for the 2021-2022 fiscal year. This final ad valorem tax shall be levied upon the 2021 Tax Assessment Roll for ad valorem tax on all taxable property located within the boundaries of the Town of White Springs, Florida.

**Section 2.** The final millage rate to be levied upon all taxable property located within the Town of White Springs is 5.5 Mills for the fiscal year commencing October 1, 2021 and ending September 30, 2022, which is 32.71% more than the rolled-back rate of 4.1445.


**Section 3.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
